PRESIDENTS REMARKS:

It was a privilege to be sworn in as your 2011 Chapter President at our December meeting. I would like to thank our board members, Immediate Past President Jim Hartman, Connie Doherty and Doug Schoenberg, whose terms expired in 2010. Each gave many years of dedicated service to our Chapter. The Great Lakes Chapter has been fortunate to have a good membership base of volunteers over the years to service on the Board of Directors, as Regional Representatives or on our various committees. There is much going on in the real estate valuation industry, nationally as well as internationally. Just as the economic downturn has forced clients and businesses to reevaluate how they are doing business to stay competitive, so must we as appraisers and as members of the Appraisal Institute. Some of the changes occurring at the Appraisal Institute include the Board of Directors' approval of the Core Competency Framework in November 2010 to be implemented over the coming years. Much has been written and disseminated about this and other changes and I recommend you visit the Appraisal Institute's web page for more information.

I'm pleased to report the Great Lakes Chapter is in sound financial condition and our membership, although fluctuating the last few years, has remained steady. This is a positive considering state licensed appraiser numbers have been in decline. As of the end of 2010 we had 184 designated plus 275 associates and affiliates for a total of 459 practicing members. It has been a challenge to balance our annual budgets but we have had good success the last couple of years with essentially break even year ends. Our cash reserves are equivalent to approximately eight months of operating expenses, which is where we want to be as a non profit organization.

The Great Lakes Chapter's annual budget is education driven. Education is where we spend the bulk of our time and energy as a Chapter. One of our primary Chapter goals has been to provide the best quality real estate appraisal education available at a cost effective price to our membership. We schedule over 25 seminars or courses per year at various locations throughout the state. The convenience of attending our local course offerings benefits our members by saving time and money. Another benefit is the networking opportunity with other real estate professionals. This is a big advantage compared to internet education.

Another benefit to membership in the Great Lakes Chapter is our voucher program. By attending a Chapter meeting you receive a voucher for \$50 off a seminar or \$100 off a course offering. This member benefit has been available since 2001; however its cost comes up each year in our budget discussions. As long as we have well attended educational offerings and our budgets are balanced we should be able to continue vouchers. I hope that as a member you are taking advantage of this benefit.

In closing I would like to ask our membership to make the commitment to support your Great Lakes Chapter by attending chapter meetings and at least one or two of our educational seminar or course offerings this year. Our 2011 Calendar of Events with our up coming seminars and courses is attached to this newsletter. It will be updated on our web page as new information and educational offerings are added. Also, look for a new and improved notice of upcoming educational offerings in your email soon. Finally, I would like to thank Joan Kaczor our Executive Director who does so much to support us as a Chapter and on the Board of Directors.

The Michigan Department of Natural Resources and Environment seeks an experienced appraiser to conduct appraisal reviews and special valuations. This is interesting, challenging work. Projects include a broad variety of appraisals - acquisitions, sales, exchanges, conservation easements, leases, wetlands, rail corridors and partial interests.

Reviewer is responsible for reviewing independent appraisals obtained by contract, performing inhouse valuations, problem-solving and advising staff and senior management. The reviewer evaluates appraisal reports, works with appraisers to ensure that appraisals meet standards, and provides insight into the opinion of value.

The review function is critical to protecting the investment of public funds in lands acquired and protecting public assets when surplus lands are exchanged or sold. Dozens of appraisals are reviewed annually, involving millions of dollars worth of property, with a variety of state and federal grants and requirements.

Minimum experience and qualifications:

- "State Certified General" license (highest level in Michigan), equivalent, or ability to obtain within 6 months of start date
- Bachelor's Degree, from four year accredited college
- Knowledge of appraisal standards, practice and review process
