State Certification Requirement for FHA Appraisers Takes Effect Oct. 1, 2009

Starting October 1, 2009, all FHA Appraiser Roster appraisers in all states and territories must be state certified (not just licensed) in order to remain on the FHA Appraiser Roster and be eligible to conduct appraisals for FHA-insured mortgages. IN MEMORIAM

Roland "Dean" Nelson passed away on March 2, 2009, after a brave but courageous battle with cancer at 81 years old. In 1953 he started his own real estate appraisal company, aptly named Dean Appraisal, which joined the National firm of Integra Realty Resources in 2000. Dean never retired and continued to counsel clients and write articles throughout the remaining days of his illness. His latest article, "Enterprise Component Allocation: Methodology Discussion," will be published in April 2009, by the CRE.

Dean was President of the Michigan Chapter of the AIREA (Now The Appraisal Institute) in 1972. He authored many articles published by various trade magazines and journals, including the following articles published by the Appraisal Journal: Real Estate Taxes and Value – 1966; Overall Rate-Band of Investment Style - 1969; Discounting Fractional Interests – 1969; The Effect of Financing on Value – 1972; Market Testing of Ellwood I & II - 1976-77; Valuation of a Terminal Grain Elevator - 1982; Hotel Enterprise Valuation - 1988; Valuation of a Pari-Mutual Racetrack - 1989; Expenses on a Triple-Net Lease – 1991.

He served on various Appraisal Institute committees including: Membership committee, Minority Relations committee, Appraisal Journal committee; and chaired committees that studied issues including appraising government subsidized apartment buildings, and cash equivalency.

A good-natured "character" with a unique sense of humor, he was always ready with a play-on-words, and loved to hear and tell jokes and tales of his adventures in and out of the business of real estate. He learned many life lessons "on the stand" and continued to share his love of the business with his friends and colleagues. He is sorely missed by his associates and friends at Integra Realty Resources – Detroit, where his advice and mentoring will carry on long beyond his physical presence.
